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Disclaimer

Under rule 22 the Club accepts no responsibility for any loss or injury to members, their families or guests, howsoever caused, and anyone entering the premises or participating in activities at the Club does so at their own risk. Parents of cadet members under 18 years old must countersign this form to signify waiver of liability for any injury or loss to their children.

Adults who are under 23 and in full time education can use cadet day sailing tariffs.

Main Conditions of Day Membership (see rules and byelaws for full details)

1. Personal Buoyancy: a life jacket or approved buoyancy aid **MUST** be worn at all times when on the water in dinghies, rescue boats, windsurfers, or on pontoons. Under 18s must not cross the water perimeter fence unless wearing a buoyancy aid.
2. Sailing Clothing: dinghy sailors and rescue boat crew must wear a wetsuit or drysuit from 1st November to 31st March. Windsurfers must wear at least a 'shortie' wetsuit all year.
3. Parental Responsibility: parents are responsible for the safety and behaviour of their children at all times. Under-11s must not be at the club unless accompanied by an adult who takes full responsibility for their safety and behaviour.
4. Winch. The powered winch can be dangerous and you should seek assistance from the Duty Team or knowledgeable club member before you use it. Under-18s may not operate the winch or control its load under any circumstance.
5. Dogs: are not allowed on reservoir premises at any time.
6. Windsurfing: is permitted at all sailing times except Wednesday evenings or before 1pm on Sundays.
7. Hire of club boats is subject to availability and may be restricted on Tuesday evenings and Sunday afternoons due to club organised training.
8. Hire of club boats can only be done by experienced and competent sailors.
