## RACING

### Race Times

Start sequences are posted on the race board.

*Spring Season (April 1st -- July 4th)* H1, C1, D2

*Summer Season (July 19st -- October 20th)* H2, C2, D2

Series H1, H2: Saturday Handicap - two back to back races, 14.30 and 15.45, single start.

Series C1, C2: Sunday morning series - class starts from 10.30

Series D1, D2: Sunday – two back to back races, 11.45 (12.20 on Sundays when series P is run), single start.

Series P: Mountfield Pursuit - first Sunday of each month, 75 minute race from 1030. Class results extracted for series C1 & C2. 4 out of 7 races to count.

Series A: Anniversary Handicap - third Sunday of each month, 1030, two starts. Class results extracted for series C1 & C2. 4 out of 7 races to count.

Series W: Wednesday evening handicap, class starts from 19.28, PTO for dates.

*Early Winter Season (Oct 31st - December 31st)* C3, D3

*Late Winter Season (Jan 1st - March 31st)* C4, D4

Series C3, C4: Sunday morning series - class starts from 10.30

Series D3, D4: Sunday - two back to back races. Single start 11.45

Series WP: Pursuit - first Sunday of each month, 60 minute race from 1030. Class results extracted for series C1 & C2. 3 out of 5 races to count.

Personal handicap series will be run in parallel with the Anniversary and Wednesday evening series.

### Race Entry

To enter a race, put your card in the entry rack before the start. **No card - £2 fine.** For back-to-back races, entry for the first automatically enters you for the second. New race cards are issued to paid-up members on 1st April.

Series P (monthly pursuit) - entry fee £1 per person for charity.

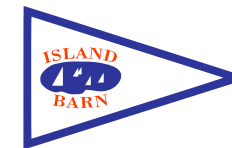
Series W (Wednesday handicap) - entry as above but you **must** sign up and carry out a duty for one race. **Failure to do this will result in disqualification from the series.**

### Safety Regulations

- Buoyancy aids must be worn at all times by any person on the water, beach or pontoons.
- At advertised club sailing times, no sailing is allowed until the green flag is flying.
- Children are always welcome, but under 16s must be supervised at all times by an adult who takes responsibility for their safety and behaviour.
- The winch and its load may only be operated by those aged 18 or over. Please assist those with junior crews.
- Wetsuits or drysuits are compulsory for sailors and rescue boat crews between Nov 1st - March 31st, and all year round for windsurfers.
- All boats at the club must be insured in accordance with the byelaws.
- Rescue boats - under 18's may drive, but must be supervised by an adult, except as defined in the byelaws.

### Sailing Times

Summer Season (March 31st - October 31st)

Saturdays: 14.30 to 17.00 except from 10.00 Open Meetings/ Regattas

Sundays: 10.30 to 17.00 Last Launch 15.30

Wednesdays: 19.00 to dusk (PTO for dates)

Tuesdays: 19.00 to dusk (PTO for dates)

Junior sailing Sunday 14.00 to 17.00 (PTO for dates)

Winter Season (November 1st - March 31st)

Sundays: 10.30 to 15.00 or at end of racing, whichever is earlier.

Other times are possible subject to self-rescue arrangements - see byelaws. Windsurfing is permitted at all the above times except before 13.00 on Sundays, or on Wednesday evenings. No sailing for other classes on open meeting days.

### Duties

Carrying out your team and fleet duties (and assisting at working parties) is not just a condition of membership, but also the only way that the club can operate; we rely on you! If a date is inconvenient, organise a swap; find a day you can do and phone through the members of that team (list in the clubhouse). **If you miss a duty you create much more work for the rest of your team, who may have to reduce the sailing and catering available.** Allow for a Sunday duty to last all day - it may be possible to reduce the team in the afternoon but it is not fair to expect the same people to stay late each time. Information you need for duty days can be found in the member's handbook. Please note that on duty days you should be at the club 90 minutes before the first race, kitted out for rescue boat duty.

All teams are divided into two halves: **A** and **B**. Members from both halves are required to attend their Sunday duties, however for Saturday duties only the indicated half need attend.
